




2024 Income

Trainings That Transform: Milestones Raises Autism Response

Confidence by 62%

Crisis moments are especially high-stakes for autistic individuals, who are **7x more likely to encounter** law enforcement and at higher risk of suicidal ideation. From January-July 2025, Milestones partnered with Cuyahoga County's ADAMHS Board to deliver 11 trainings for police, EMTs, and **community providers**—equipping them with autism expertise to save lives and build safer, more inclusive communities.

Helpdesk in the Community: Closing Gaps, Building Trust

For families navigating autism, access to help often depends on whether the right door opens at the right time. The Milestones Helpdesk embeds support in trusted community spaces and to ensure no one is left without a path forward. From January–June 2025, in partnership with MetroHealth and United Way, the Helpdesk reached families in clinics, libraries, Head Start centers, and cultural events—on track to support more than 1,200 families this year.

At the MetroHealth Autism Clinic alone, families received direct scheduling, referrals, and follow-up support.



WITH GRATITUDE: A LEGACY OF LOVE AND LEADERSHIP

Milestones Autism Resources was founded in 2003 by Ilana Hoffer Skoff and Mia Buchwald Gelles, two mothers who met in their children's speech therapy waiting room. Out of their shared need for guidance and community, they built the organization they once wished for themselves.

What began as a grassroots effort has grown into a trusted leader serving thousands each year through the free Autism Helpdesk, online Resource Center, Training Workshops, and the Milestones National Autism Conference, which now attracts participants from across the country and around the world.

Over two decades, Ilana and Mia guided Milestones from a staff of two to a team of 20. They championed autistic voices, hiring autistic employees and including self-advocates as interns, board members, and conference presenters. Their vision ensured autistic individuals weren't just served by Milestones, but also helped shape its programs and direction.









The founders also recognized deep disparities in autism diagnosis and care. They launched the free Spanish Helpdesk and forged a partnership with MetroHealth Medical Center to offer onsite services for Black and Hispanic communities. By investing in DEIA initiatives, Ilana and Mia broke down barriers and brought vital resources to families who had long been overlooked.

Through all of this, Ilana and Mia never lost sight of their original purpose: to make sure no one would feel alone on this journey.

Their legacy lives on in every call answered, every connection made, and every life changed. Milestones is, at its heart, a reflection of their love, their courage, and their belief in the power of community.
