Call for Proposals:

The Call for Proposals opens Monday, December 10, 2012 and closes Friday, January 25, 2013. You may submit one or more proposals in any of the following categories:

• Workshop Session: 60 or 75 minute session presented by 1 or 2 speakers

• Panel Presentation: 75 minute session presented by up to 4 speakers

Poster Session: Poster displayed in selected area of conference site

2. Selection Process:

- A. A confirmation letter stating that your proposal has been received will be sent to the lead presenter upon submission.
- B. A Conference Committee comprised of parents and professionals will review each proposal.

- C. The Conference Committee may request that some submitters refine their proposals to create the best possible content for the intended audience.
- D. Presenters will be notified in writing if their proposals have been accepted. If your proposal is not selected to be presented at the annual conference as a workshop session, it may be selected for a poster session at the conference or for a Milestones parent or professional workshop series which occur periodically throughout the year.
- E. Presenters will be notified of the date and time they will speak.
